
The Life Cycle of a Sea Turtle

Females use their back flippers to dig a small hole into which they deposit their eggs.



When fully developed, hatchlings break through their eggshell and slowly dig their way to the surface.



To avoid any predators, hatchlings will generally wait until night to head for the ocean.



Each nesting season, most females return to nest at the same beach which they hatched on.
